

Privacy Policy

We highly recommend that you carefully review our Privacy Policy as it is an essential component of the agreement between you, also known as the "User," and Profinus.

The Privacy Policy outlines the procedures that Profinus (referred to as "the Company") follows regarding your personal information. Our company takes the security of our customers' personal data very seriously and is committed to maintaining the confidentiality of this information. To prevent the loss, abuse, alteration, or unauthorized access of your information by third parties, we adhere to all necessary organizational and technical requirements.

This policy outlines how we handle and use your information. By agreeing to the Privacy Policy, customers consent to the collection, storage, and use of their information in accordance with this policy and relevant laws. Customers can withdraw their consent and request the removal of their data by contacting us.

What information can the company disclose to certain third parties?

Personal data will not be disclosed to any third party unless one of the following conditions applies. We may share your information with outside companies, organizations, or individuals if we have a reasonable belief that it is necessary for one of the following reasons: to comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal proceedings, or government requests; to enforce current laws, including investigating potential violations; to detect and prevent fraud, support security, or address technical issues; to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our users, or the public as permitted or required by law; with our group companies, third-party service providers, and partners who process your information to provide services to the Company or for other purposes described in this Policy; or with any law enforcement, regulatory, government agency, court, or other third party as required by law.

We may share identifiable information with our partners and the public for various purposes, such as demonstrating trends in the use of our website. If we participate in a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, we will maintain the confidentiality of personal data and notify users before any transfer of data or change in privacy policy. We do not disclose users' personal information, such as their name or email address, to other users. Your data may be transferred to a third party in another country for further processing in compliance with this Policy. This could involve the transfer of data to countries with different levels of protection than your country of residence, but we will take adequate measures, such as technical, contractual, or legal safeguards, to ensure your privacy rights are protected.

Company security measures

The Company implements suitable administrative and technical measures to safeguard the information it gathers and handles.

The Company takes various measures to ensure the security of the information it

collects and processes, including but not limited to:

- Storing information on secure servers.
- Utilizing encrypted transmission links.
- Implementing additional security measures such as firewalls, authentication systems, access controls to prevent unauthorized access to systems and data.
- Conducting regular reviews of its information collection, storage, and processing practices, including physical security measures, to prevent unauthorized access to its systems.
- Limiting access to information to employees, contractors, and agents who require access for processing purposes.

Automatic decision-making

At times, we may use your data to make automatic decisions (such as profiling) that have a legal impact on you or significantly affect you in another way. An automatic decision refers to a decision made about you using software algorithms without human intervention. If we make an automatic decision that concerns you, you have the right to contest the decision, express your opinion, and ask for the decision to be reconsidered.
